TRACK DESCRIPTION

What is the issue?

All over the world, children and teenagers are in crisis. It's happening right in our city, too. Beginning with abortion as the first attack, it's clear that the powers of darkness are working overtime to destroy the lives of kids. We'll talk about abuse, trafficking of children, poverty and homelessness, and shocking issues around the world such as child marriage and child soldiers.

What's being done about it?

Could you picture yourself someday working in an orphanage, a refugee camp or a shelter for abused kids? What about bringing justice and freedom to kids who are caught up in trafficking or other kinds of abuse? Many Christians have heard the call to reach out to the huge needs of kids and make it the focus of their ministries. Maybe God will call you, too.

What will they do during IYW?

The Training time will be led by Staci Miller, who served in a children's home in Mexico and now leads a weekly outreach to at risk children here in El Paso. This eye-opening presentation will be full of stories and photos of kids in crisis. You won't get bored!

The Outreach time will give you an opportunity to put your training into action. You will work alongside El Paso leaders in youth ministry and teenagers who already have worldwide experience ministering to kids through King's Kids. We will serve the community through a kids' program with a variety of stations involving sports, crafts/activities, a Gospel message or drama, and snacks at a public housing project where we have the opportunity to connect, engage and share our hope and future in Christ with at-risk kids & youth.
